

NORTHWEST MISSOURI STALLION OWNER FUTURITY RULES

1. All stallions must be nominated and purchased through the NWMSOF to be an eligible stallion.
 - A. You can pay a one-time nomination fee of \$250.00 for the eligibility to show one (1) foal for its lifetime; that is out of a non-eligible stallion. All entry fees for memberships, entry fees, etc. still apply.
2. All Exhibitor(s) and Owner(s) must be paid members and in good standing to participate in the Futurity and meetings.
3. All Exhibitor(s) and Owner(s) must abide by AQHA, IBHA, ABRA, PHBA, APHA, NSBA, ApHC, POA and PtHA rules.
4. FOALS
 - A. Only foals that are out of an eligible stallion may be shown at the futurity. The only exception is in reference to 1.A.
 - B. The weanling division will be split between early and late foals; determined upon the total number of foals registered for the futurity.
5. ENTRIES
 - A. There will be No Refunds.
 - B. There will be an office fee of \$20.00 per horse.
 - C. There will be a minimum of five (5) places to be paid out. All payments will be mailed out after the show.
6. SUBSTITUTIONS
 - A. The Board of Directors or Futurity Committee must be notified before September 1; if a foal is to be substituted.
 - B. A substitution is allowable upon death or severe injury; as long as the Board of Directors has received proper documentation from a licensed Veterinarian.
 - C. The substitution foal must be out of an eligible stallion.
 - D. The substitution foal will be for any eligible class for the foal born in the year.
7. STALLION MONIES
 - A. The stallion money will be put into a NWMSOF savings account.
 - B. Ten percent (10%) of the total stallion fees shall be appropriated to the NWMSOF checking account for operating fees.
 - C. The stallion monies will be appropriated accordingly.
 - a. 20% Weanlings

- b. 20% Yearlings
- c. 20% Two (2) Year Olds
- d. 20% Three (3) Year Olds
- e. 20% Four (4) Year Olds

8. JUDGES

- A. Competent judge(s) will be hired to judge all classes.
- B. Judges Fee(s) and Arena Fee(s) will be paid with a percentage of the Stallion and Entry Fee Monies.
- C. All results are final.

9. COLOR CLASS

- A. Foal(s) must have papers in one of the following breed associations: IBRA, ABRA, PHBA, APHA, ApHC or PtHA. The foal(s) are to be judged on the preferred color of that breed association.
- B. Foal(s) that are breeding stock and color bred that do not exhibiting coloring; will not be eligible to show.
- C. The color class is to be judged 100% on color.
- D. The color class will be judged in a moving circle moving both directions.

10. WEANLING HALTER CLASS

- A. Foal(s) must be out of an eligible stallion.
- B. The weanling class will be split in the following classes:
 - a. Senior Stallions
 - b. Junior Stallions
 - c. Senior Mares
 - d. Junior Mares
- C. Grand and Reserve Stallion will be chosen from 1st and 2nd placing in the Senior and Junior Stallions class.
- D. Grand and Reserve Mare will be chosen from 1st and 2nd placing in the Senior and Junior Mares class.

11. YEARLING HALTER CLASS

- A. Foal(s) must be out of an eligible stallion.
- B. The yearlings will be split into the following classes:
 - a. Stallions and Geldings
 - b. Mares

12. TWO (2) YEAR OLD HALTER CLASS

- A. Foal(s) must be out of an eligible stallion.
- B. The two (2) year olds will be split into the following classes:
 - a. Stallions and Geldings
 - b. Mares

13. THREE (3) AND FOUR (4) YEAR OLD HALTER CLASS
 - A. Foal(s) must be out of an eligible stallion.
 - B. The three (3) and four (4) year olds will be split into the following:
 - a. Stallions and Geldings
 - b. Mares
14. YEARLING LONGELINE
 - A. Foal(s) must be out of an eligible stallion.
 - B. Current NSBA rules apply except for one rule regarding exhibitor(s). The NWMSOF will allow an exhibitor to show more than one entry.
 - C. The Pattern for Conformation and Trot-Off Soundness is as follows:
 1. The horse is walked to the first cone and paused for conformation judging.
 2. After judge(s) inspection, the horse is trotted around cone for soundness.
 3. Any horse(s) showing evidence of lameness should be excused from the class immediately.
15. TWO (2) YEAR OLD WESTERN PLEASURE SNAFFLE
 - A. Horse(s) must be out of an eligible stallion.
 - B. Current NSBA rules and equipment apply.
 - C. Horse(s) exhibited in the TWO (2) YEAR OLD SNAFFLE will not be allowed to exhibit in the TWO (2) YEAR OLD IDEAL STOCK HORSE.
16. TWO (2) YEAR OLD IDEAL STOCK HORSE SNAFFLE
 - A. Horse(s) must be out of an eligible stallion.
 - B. Current NSBA rules and equipment apply except for one rule regarding age of horse(s). The NWMSOF will allow two (2) year olds to be judged according to the NSBA rules.
 - C. Horse(s) exhibited in the TWO (2) YEAR OLD IDEAL STOCK HORSE will not be allowed to exhibit in the TWO (2) YEAR OLD SNAFFLE.
 - D. Horse(s) will be judged on NSBA rules in regards to Ranch Riding.
 - E. Horse(s) will be judged upon two different categories:
 1. Ranch Riding – 1st portion 50%
 2. Conformation – 2nd portion 50%
 - a. After exhibitors have performed the riding portion of the class; they will be asked to remove saddles in the arena and set up for the conformation portion of the class.
17. THREE (3) AND FOUR (4) YEAR OLD WESTERN PLEASURE
 - A. Horse(s) must be out of an eligible stallion.
 - B. Current AQHA rules and equipment apply.

- C. Horse(s) exhibited in the THREE (3) AND FOUR (4) YEAR OLD WESTERN PLEASURE will not be allowed to exhibit in the THREE (3) AND FOUR (4) YEAR OLD IDEAL STOCK PLEASURE class.
18. THREE (3) AND FOUR (4) YEAR OLD IDEAL STOCK PLEASURE
- A. Horse(s) must be out of an eligible stallion.
- B. Current AQHA rules and equipment apply.
- C. Horse(s) exhibited in the THREE (3) AND FOUR (4) YEAR OLD IDEAL STOCK PLEASURE will not be allowed to exhibit in the THREE (3) AND FOUR (4) YEAR OLD WESTERN PLEASURE class.
- D. Horse(s) will be judged on AQHA rules in regards to Ranch Riding.
- E. Horse(s) will be judged upon two different categories:
1. Ranch Riding – 1st portion 50%
 2. Conformation – 2nd portion 50%
 - a. After exhibitors have performed the riding portion of the class; they will be asked to remove saddles in the arena and set up for the conformation portion of the class.
19. REINING – THREE (3) AND FOUR (4) YEAR OLDS
- A. Horse(s) must be out of an eligible stallion.
- B. Current NRHA rules and equipment apply.
20. OPEN CLASSES
- A. All open classes will be judged according to the following associations in order of preference.
1. AQHA
 2. NRHA
21. SUPER HORSE AWARD
- A. Horse(s) must be out of an eligible stallion.
- B. Beginning with the 2012 foals; the futurity will keep points on foals thought their futurity career. The foal with the most points will be awarded the Super Horse Award. The first award will be given at the 2014 Stallion Auction.
- C. Points are to be awarded as follows:

D. The above points are to be awarded in the following classes:

1. Weanling Stallions – Early
2. Weanling Stallions – Late
3. Weanling Mares – Early
4. Weanling Mares – Late
5. Yearling Stallions/Geldings
6. Yearling Mares
7. Two (2) Year Old Stallions/Geldings
8. Two (2) Year Old Mares
9. Three (3) and Four (4) Year Old Stallions/Geldings
10. Three (3) and Four (4) Year Old Mares
11. Yearling Longeline
12. Two (2) Year Old Western Pleasure Snaffle
13. Two (2) Year Old Ideal Stock Horse Pleasure
14. Three (3) and Four (4) Year Old Stallions/Geldings
15. Three (3) and Four (4) Year Old Mares
16. Reining – Three (3) and Four (4) Year Olds

22. SIRE OF THE YEAR AWARD

Points shall be awarded based on the total number of Futurity eligible horses actually judged in the Futurity class. All horses must be placed. For example, if there are twenty head shown; then first place would get twenty (20) points, second place would get nineteen (19) points, so on and so forth.
